## Independence Day Road Closures

On July 4, the following roads will be closed from 7:30 p.m. to midnight for the fireworks display:

### Total closures include:

Cardinal Dr., Chapman Way, Kelok Rd., Lamont Way, Lords Ln. and all intersecting streets within the closure zone.

### Partial road closures include:

Bryant Rd. (Lakeview Blvd. to Jean Rd.), Lakeview Blvd. (Bryant Rd. to Iron Mountain Blvd.), and South Shore Blvd. (Westview Dr. to Lakeview Blvd.).

### Streets with one side parking restrictions include:

Alder Cir., Allen Rd., Graef Cir., Maple Cir., Upper Dr., and Greenbrier Rd.

Parking restrictions will be in effect all day July 4. All posted streets are "tow away" zones.

Residents will be allowed vehicle access. Guest must arrive by 7:30 p.m., or have an invitation with the host's name and address.
