

Fire Department Divisions



There are five major divisions that make up the Lake Oswego Fire Department. Fire Operations, Fire Prevention, Fire Department Training, Emergency Management and Emergency Medical Services.

[Fire Operations](#)

Fire Operations is responsible for 24-hour fire, rescue and emergency medical services to the citizens of Lake Oswego and the citizens of our contracted districts, Lake Grove Rural Fire District, Alto Park Water District and Riverdale Dunthorpe Fire District.

[Fire Prevention](#)

Fire Prevention is responsible for fire and life safety of new construction, maintenance inspections, public education, fire investigation and juvenile firesetter intervention.

[Fire Department Training](#)

Fire training is responsible for providing the many hours of training our firefighters and medics are required to maintain and includes Fire Operations, Emergency Medical Services and Water Dive Rescue Training.

[Emergency Management](#)

The Fire Department and City Manager's Office oversee the City's Emergency Management Program. This program is responsible for planning, preparing, and providing for the prevention, mitigation and management of emergencies or disasters that present a threat to the lives and property of citizens of Lake Oswego. This includes coordinating and facilitating emergency planning, preparedness, response, and recovery activities.
