Participants telephone their grocery order into the center's receptionist at 503-635-3758 on Tuesday mornings between 10:00 a.m. and 12:00p.m. Then on Wednesdays a volunteer shops, delivers, and assists in putting the groceries away. Co-sponsored with the Clackamas County Senior Citizens Council. A service fee of \$3.00 per delivery is charged.

Non-Driving Individuals

On Monday afternoons the [Lunch & Shop Program](#) takes participants by van to Safeway or Walmart (coming in September) for one hour of shopping. Participants can come into the center on the morning van, have lunch, leave at 1:00 p.m., and then return home. Driver can assist with parcels as needed. Lift equipped minibus. \$1.00 suggested donation each way.
