

Family Circle Survey Methodology

With the help of Onboard Informatics, a New York City research firm that provides real estate, demographic and other data, Family Circle initially assembled a list of 3,335 cities and towns with populations between 11,000 and 150,000. From that list, some 1,300 localities having a high concentration of households with median incomes between \$55,000 and \$96,000 were selected. They then assessed which places best met their family-friendly criteria - including affordable homes, quality schools, access to health care, green space, low crime rate and financial stability - and ranked them from top to bottom. Family Circle selected the 10 winners from among the highest-rated towns.
