- There is no charge to participate, and there is no need to register.

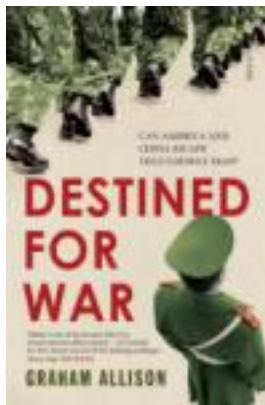
