



NOTICE OF MINOR DEVELOPMENT DECISION

Applicant: City of Lake Oswego, 4101 Kruse Way, PO Box 369, Lake Oswego, OR 97034

Location of Property: Multiple locations within the public rights-of-way of Highway 43 (Pacific Highway) and Iron Mountain Boulevard.

Description of Proposal: The applicant is requesting approval of the following in order to construct a water pipeline extending from the southerly City limits of Lake Oswego on Highway 43 to the east property line of Waluga Park:

- Resource Protection (RP) and Resource Conservation (RC) delineations; and
- Development review to construct the water pipeline through delineated resources in multiple areas along the alignment of the pipeline.

Description of Decision: Staff has approved this application subject to the conditions set forth in the staff report. This decision will become final unless appealed as described below.
