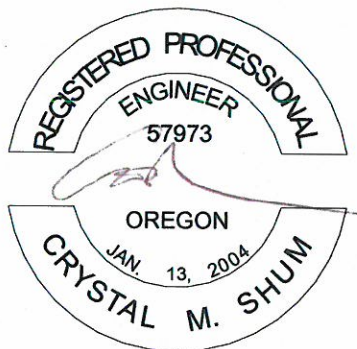

Sealed proposals for **Work Order 177 – Pavement Preservation – Crack Sealing** for the City of Lake Oswego will be received by **Crystal M. Shum, P.E., Associate Engineer**, at the 3rd floor reception desk in Lake Oswego City Hall at 380 A Avenue, Lake Oswego, Oregon, 97034 until **2:00 PM**, local time, on **Thursday, September 5, 2013** and then will be publicly opened and read.

The scope of work includes crack sealing on sections of Boones Ferry Road, Fosberg Road, Kruse Way, South Shore Boulevard, Overlook Drive, Cardinal Drive, Hallinan Street, Country Club Road, and McNary Parkway. Temporary Traffic Control will be required for all in roadway work.

No proposal will be considered by the Owner unless the proposal contains, or is accompanied by, a statement by the bidder as part of the proposal that the provision required by ORS 279C.840 pertaining to prevailing wages shall be included in the contract. The contract documents may be reviewed, examined, and copies obtained at the City Engineering Dept., 3rd Floor, Lake Oswego City Hall, 380 A Avenue, Lake Oswego, Oregon between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, except legal holidays. Copies may be obtained upon payment of a non-refundable fee of \$25. Copies of the contract documents may also be obtained by mail upon request (phone: 503.635.0270; fax: 503.635.0269) and upon the receipt of an additional \$5.00 per contract document to cover postage and handling. Requests sent through the mail shall be addressed to the Engineering Department, City of Lake Oswego, P.O. Box 369, Lake Oswego, Oregon 97034.

Contractors shall submit Supplemental Statement of Qualification Forms to the City no later than the date and time set forth above for submission of the bid.

The Owner will investigate and determine the qualifications of the apparent low bidder as part of its evaluation of the lowest responsive bid.

The purpose in completing this supplemental qualifications statement is to allow Bidders to demonstrate their qualifications to perform the Work contemplated by these Contract Documents. The Supplemental Statement of Qualifications form(s) shall be completed and submitted with the Bid at the office of the Engineer on the date and time set for Bid Closing as indicated in the Invitation for Bids – REVISED.

General Requirements

Bidder is requested to identify not less than three (3) projects completed by Bidder within the last five (5) years involving crack sealing and temporary traffic control. Information for each project shall be provided and shall include the following:

1. Project title, descriptions and major classes of work undertaken by Bidder
2. Name and current phone number(s) of Owner contact
3. Project completion date
4. Original contract award amount and final contract amount

Owner will evaluate the information provided by Bidder in response to the requirements of this supplemental qualifications statement as well as other information Owner may request in order to determine the qualifications of each Bidder. Generally, Owner will evaluate Bidder's information to determine:

1. Qualifications and experience of Bidders personnel who would construct the Work;
2. Knowledge and experience in constructing public works similar to those contemplated by these Contract Documents;
3. Ability of Bidder to timely prosecute the work to completion within the Contract Times identified in the Agreement.
