1. Who is eligible to win our prizes?

If a reader is age 18 or over, has a LINCC library card, and has registered as a participant in our Adult Summer Reading Program, each online form they fill out counts as one chance to win a prize.

Alas, employees of the Lake Oswego Public Library are not eligible to win prizes.

2. How do readers participate?

For each book read or listened to, participants fill out an online form. All required information must be entered on the form in order to be entered in the drawing.

3. How and when can people register to participate in the Adult Summer Reading Program?

Participants can register online June 1 through August 31. Register online at lopl.org/summer

You will create a user account for yourself or your household, and then a reader profile for each of you signing up for the program.

4. Must participants read books in the library's collection?

No.

5. How long does a book have to be to count for the drawing?

We usually consider a 'book' a volume of 175 pages or more, but we don't check up on this. It's up to you.

6. What's the scoop on prizes?

We are programming our computer to randomly select the winners of 13 smaller weekly prizes. Over the course of the summer, an individual may win only one weekly prize. However, all entries (including those of winners drawn throughout the summer) will be entered in the Grand Prize drawing. Our computer will give us the winner of the Grand Prize in early September. All winners will be notified via telephone, email, or postal mail. All prizes will be held for winners until the end of October 2021. Prizes not claimed by November 1 must, alas, be forfeited.

Our Grand Prize is a gift certificate for a stay at the Oregon Coast. Weekly prizes include gift cards for books and edibles.
