

Friends of the Library



The Friends started as a support group in 1953 to help furnish a reading room for the library. Fund-raising was initially accomplished with yearly book sales. These became too popular and unwieldy to handle. In 1991, the Friends opened the Booktique, a used bookstore. Books are donated to the store and it is staffed by volunteers.

Funds are raised primarily through sales at the [Booktique](#), along with dues and donations. Cash grants are awarded to the library twice a year.
