

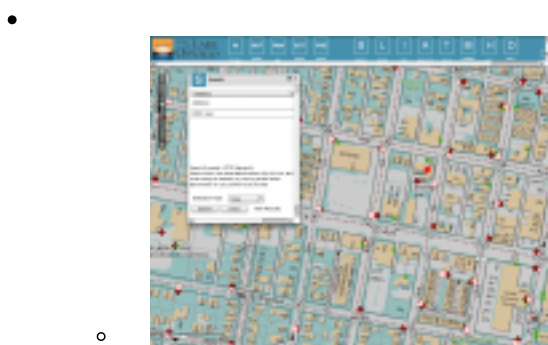
How Do I?
