The Aubrey R. Watzek Library is exhibiting a selection of photographs, manuscripts, books, and artifacts from the archives, showcasing materials from each period of Stafford's life and career. Of particular note is a selection from Stafford's extensive photo collection, featuring his family, friends, and poets from around the world. A guided introduction to the exhibit will be followed by a presentation on this extraordinary collection by Doug Erickson, Head of Special Collections/College Archivist, and Director of Oregon Poetic Voices
