

At Foothills Park on Monday, May 29 at 11 a.m., join the City as we partner with the LO Veterans Memorial to honor those who have sacrificed their lives for our nation.

The event features a keynote address from Sandra Spatz-Wiszneauckas. A Lake Oswego resident, she served in the US Marine Corps from 1966-1969 and works as a pivotal member of the Women's Marine Corps Association. Spatz-Wiszneaukas also co-founded the 641 Chapter of Vietnam Veterans of America in her former hometown of Silver Springs, Maryland, that helps maintain the Vietnam Memorial Wall and promotes legislation beneficial to Veterans.
