

McEwan Sidewalk: Project Background

- The City of Lake Oswego is creating several new pathways and sidewalks to connect neighborhoods with local area schools, businesses, parks and other community destinations.
- In 2025, Lake Oswego City Council approved completing design of a new sidewalk on McEwan Road, between SW 65th Avenue and Kristi Way.
- This project is a partnership with the Lake Oswego School District and provides a critical connection to the River Grove Elementary School.
- City project team members engaged directly impacted residents and property owners in fall 2025 to discuss the project and receive input.
- Design is now complete! Construction is expected to start in mid-late May 2026 and continue through summer.



Project Features

The final design includes:

- 1,500 ft of 6-ft wide concrete sidewalk on the north side of McEwan Road, between Kristi Way and SW 65th Avenue;
- 2,400 sq feet of stormwater planters;
- 3 curb ramps;
- 2 new stormwater maintenance holes and 1 new catch basin;
- Removing 4 trees

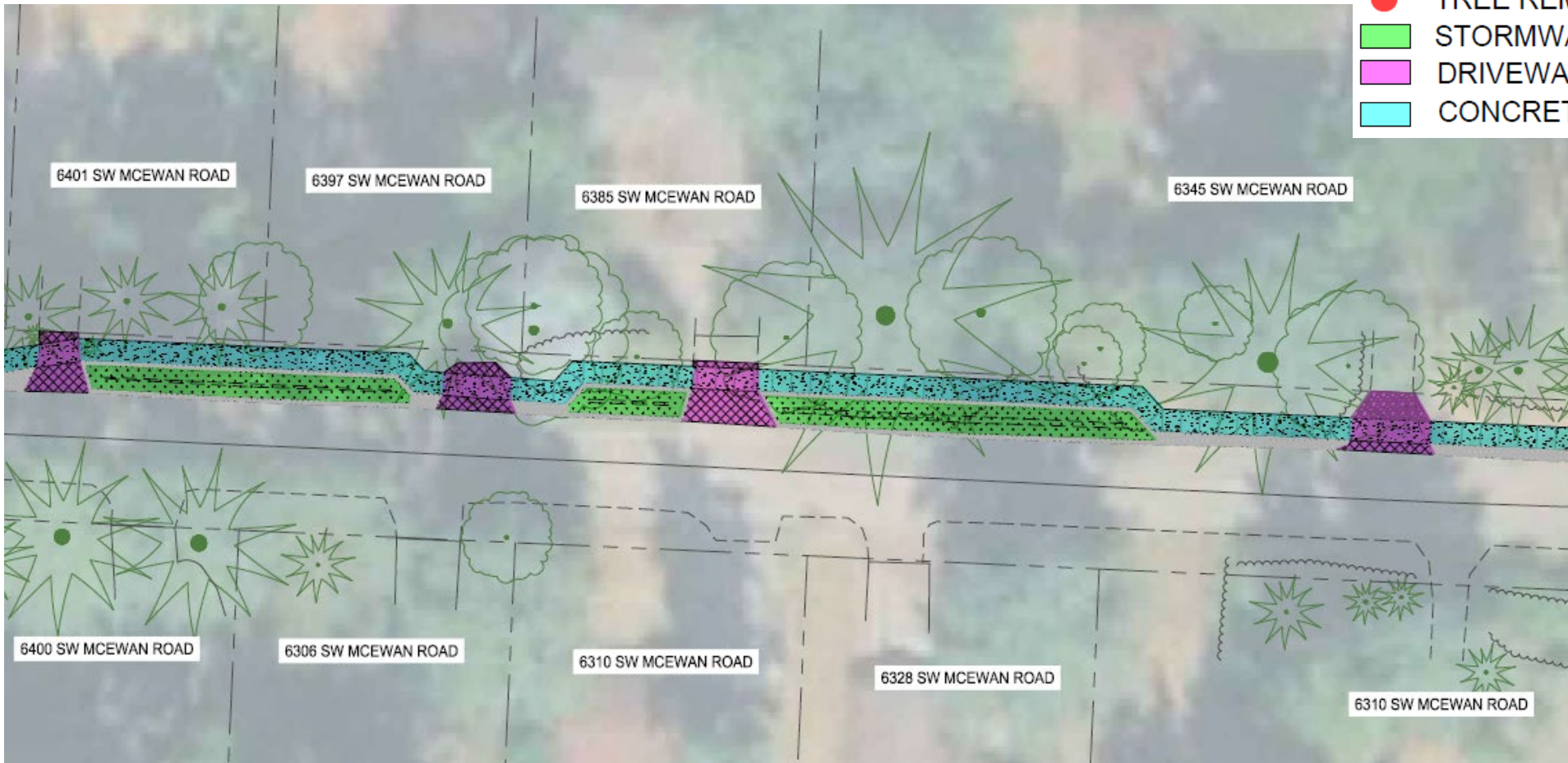

What to Expect During Construction

- Expect brief delays, dust, vibration, and noise from activities and equipment.
- Work hours are 7 am – 6 pm Monday to Friday.
- While school is in session, expect lane closures on McEwan from 9 am – 3 pm.
- When school is out of session, there will be temporary road closures on segments of McEwan Road from 7 am – 6 pm. Detours will be in place for through traffic.
- Access will remain open to residents, school, emergency services, mail, and garbage collection.
- The project team and contractor will coordinate driveway reconstruction or mailbox relocations with impacted residents in advance.
