

Country Club Road Improvement Project

Lane Closures Coming Soon!

This project includes utility and roadway improvements on Country Club Road between 10th Street and Six Corners (intersection of Iron Mountain Boulevard/C Avenue/ Bayberry Road), and a portion of 10th Street (between A and B Avenues).

Construction planned for early January through early summer 2019



Temporary Traffic Changes and Lane Closures

During construction, several temporary traffic revisions* will be in place 24/7.

- Country Club Road will be reduced to two lanes – one travel lane in each direction – and traffic will be shifted
- Stop signs will be temporarily removed for east and westbound traffic on Country Club Road at Six Corners intersection
- C Avenue, 10th Street and the northbound leg of Iron Mountain Boulevard will be closed at Country Club Road
- Traffic speed may be reduced through the corridor

* These adjustments are subject to change throughout construction, but will be restored to the previous configuration after the project is complete.

From early January through early summer, people walking, biking and driving should expect significant travel delays, plan ahead, or use an alternate route.

What to Expect During Construction

Construction will be disruptive.

The project includes stormwater, sewer and waterline installation, roadway demolition, roadway surface preparation and grading, concrete formwork, placement, curing and asphalt paving.

Work hours Monday - Friday, 7 a.m. - 6 p.m., and some Saturdays, 8 a.m. - 6 p.m. There may be night work or weekend work (advanced notice will be provided).

Neighborhood disruption Construction can be loud, dusty, create vibrations and cause traffic delays. Working equipment includes truck traffic, excavators, vibratory compactors, pavement cutters, generators, steel plates and other heavy equipment. Equipment and materials may be stored on streets in the public right-of-way (during and after hours) and within the work zones.

Access Crews will work with residents who live in the work zone to provide reasonable and safe access to homes while work is occurring. Fire and emergency services will always have access to the neighborhood.

Closed side streets Residents on C Avenue (between Six Corners and 10th Street) will need to access their street from 10th Street. Residents on 10th Street (between A and B Avenues) will need to access their street from B Avenue. Residents on the northern leg of Iron Mountain Boulevard will need to access their street from Bayberry Road and Six Corners intersection.
