We are making every effort to complete this pedestrian change before school is back in session, and minimizing morning commute times.

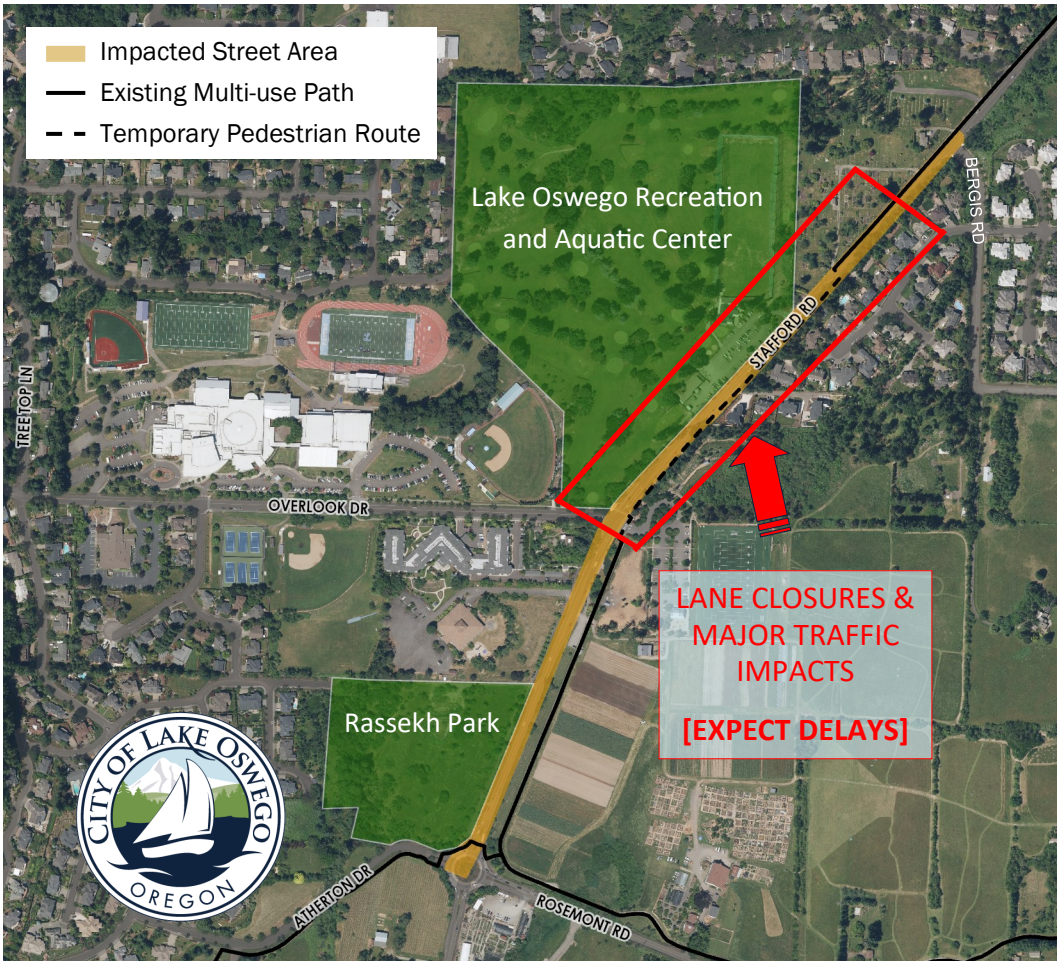
