# Dry Recreation Survey

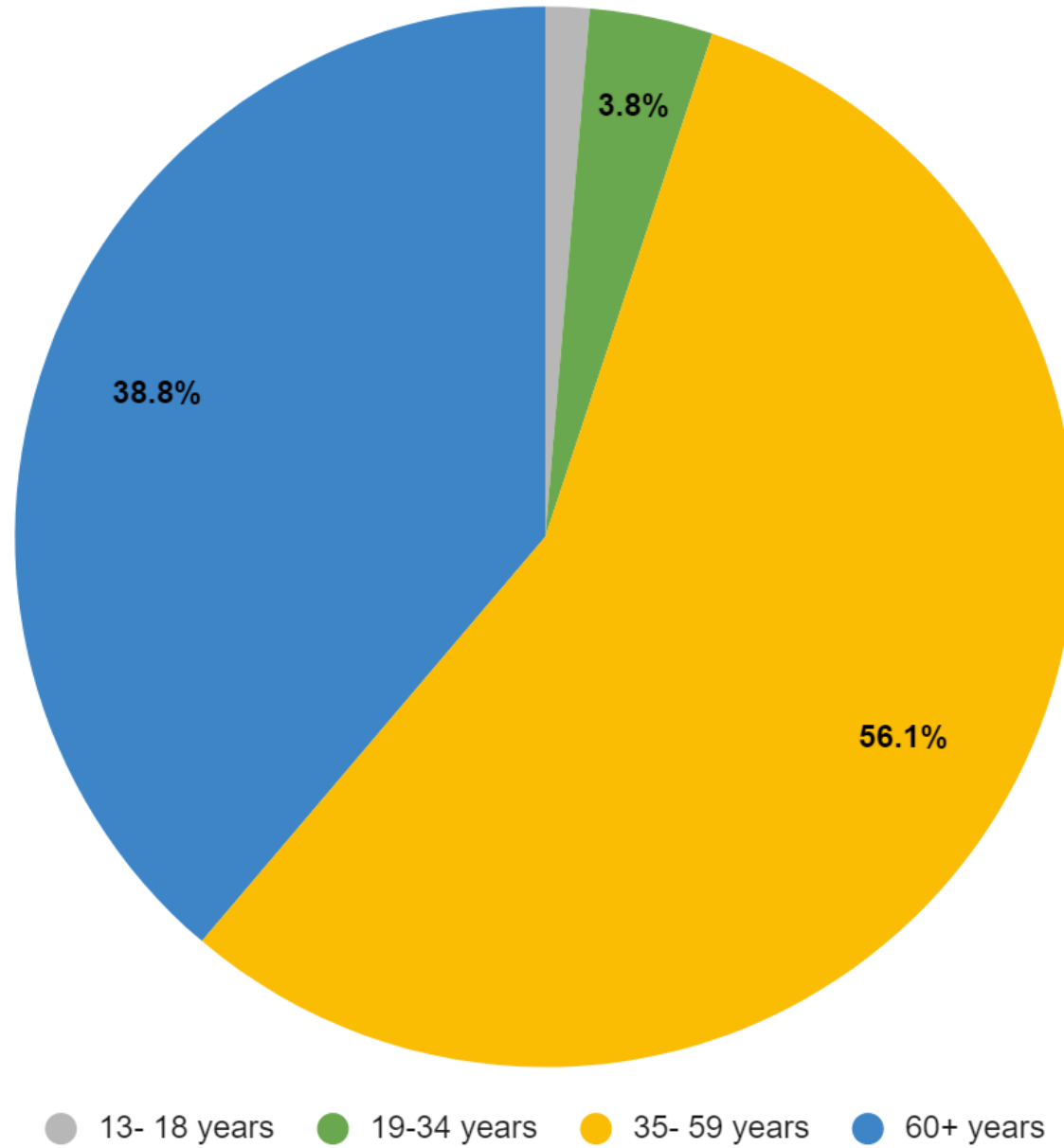

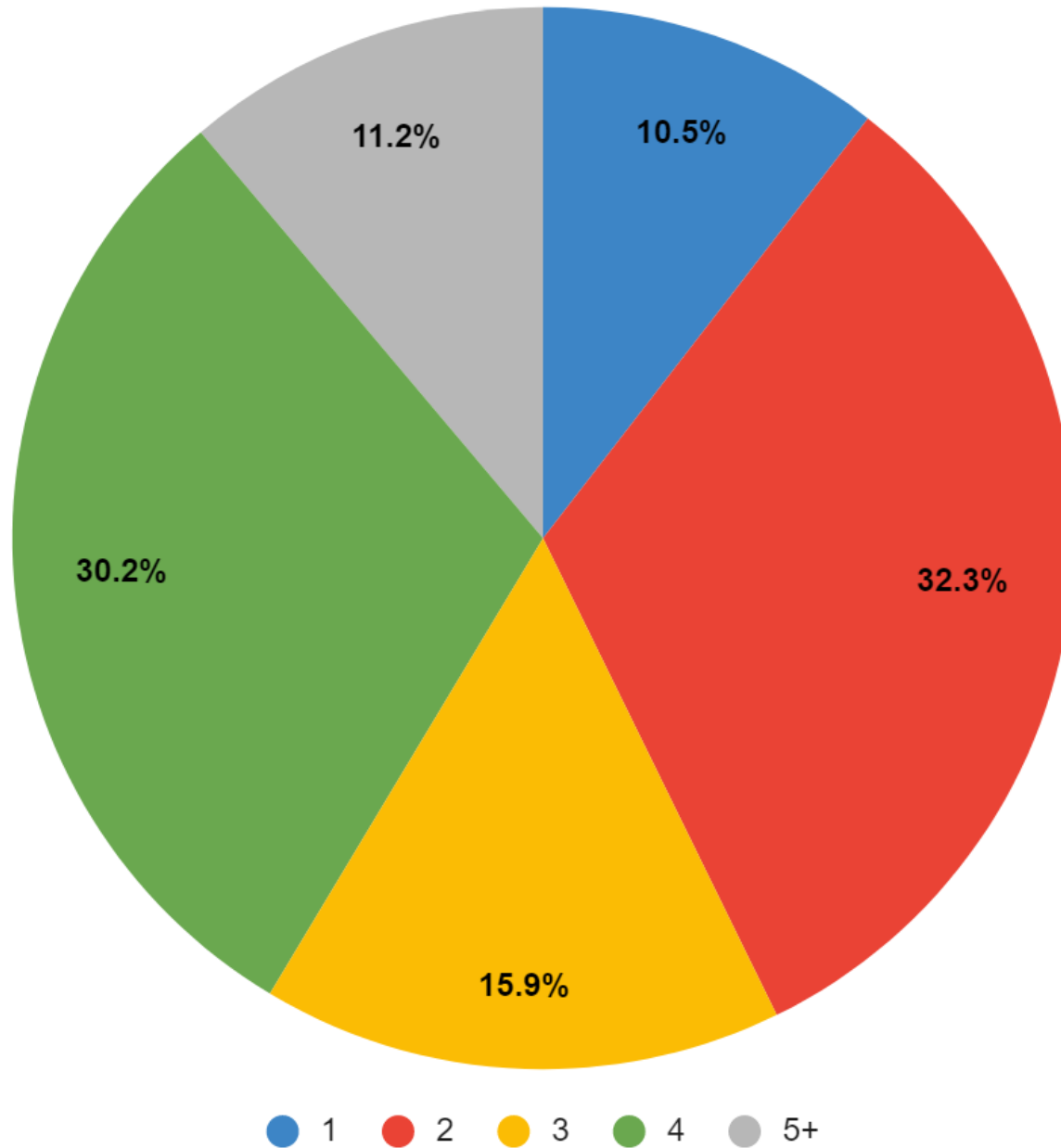

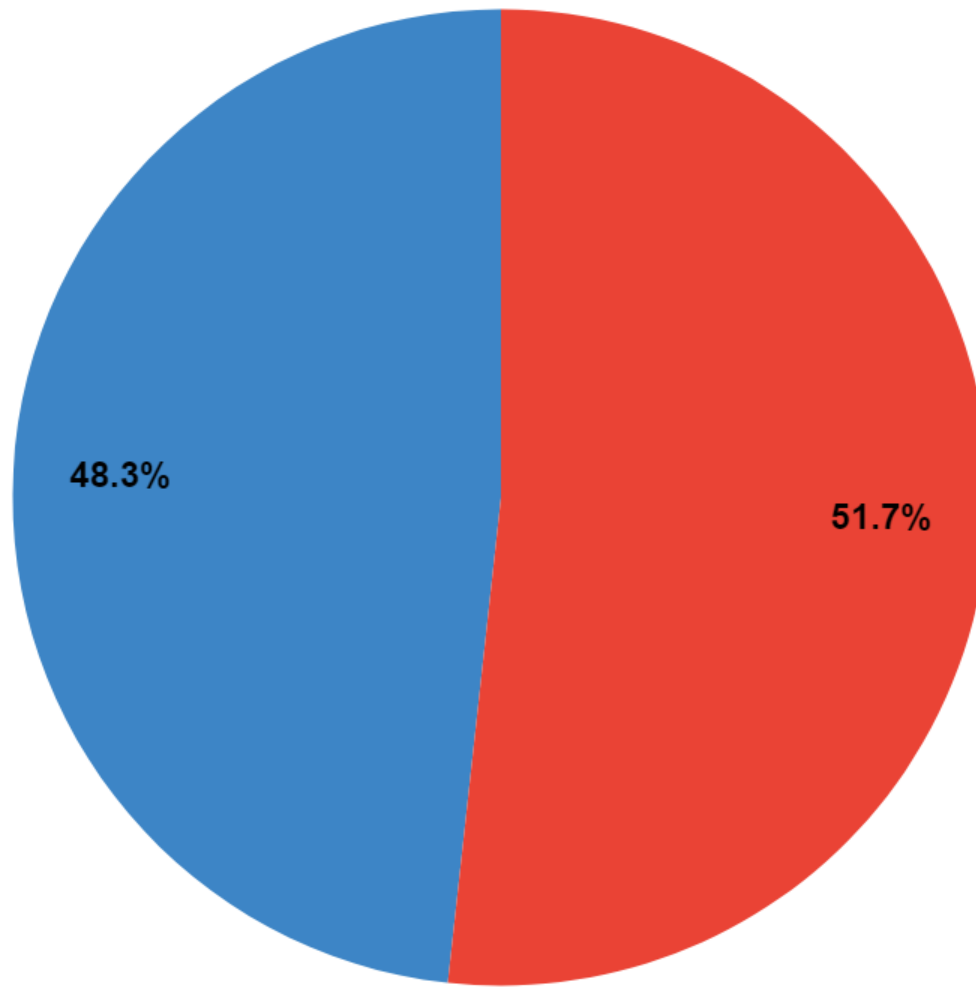
# What age group best describes you?



# How many people are in your household?

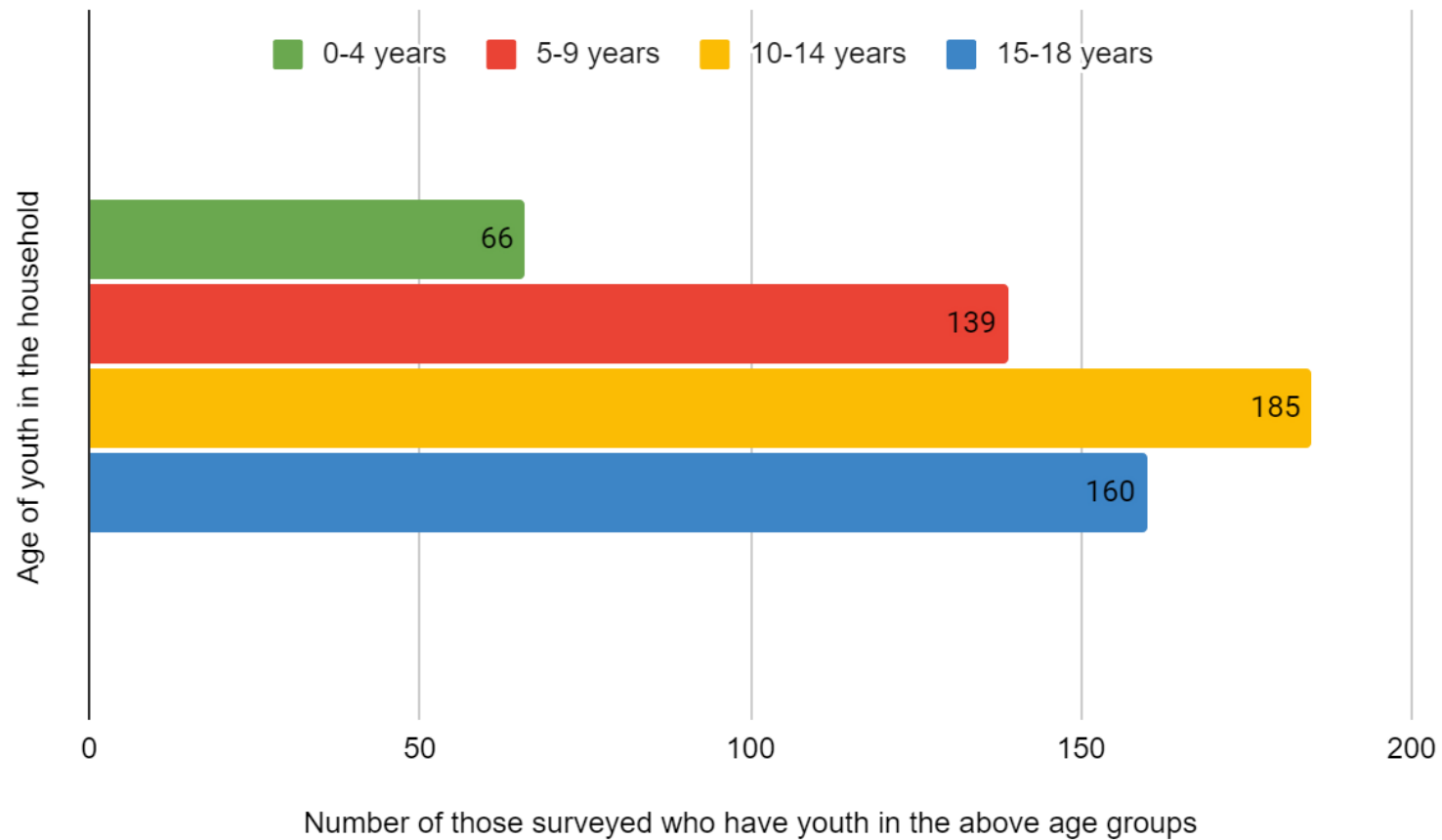


# Do you have youth in your household?

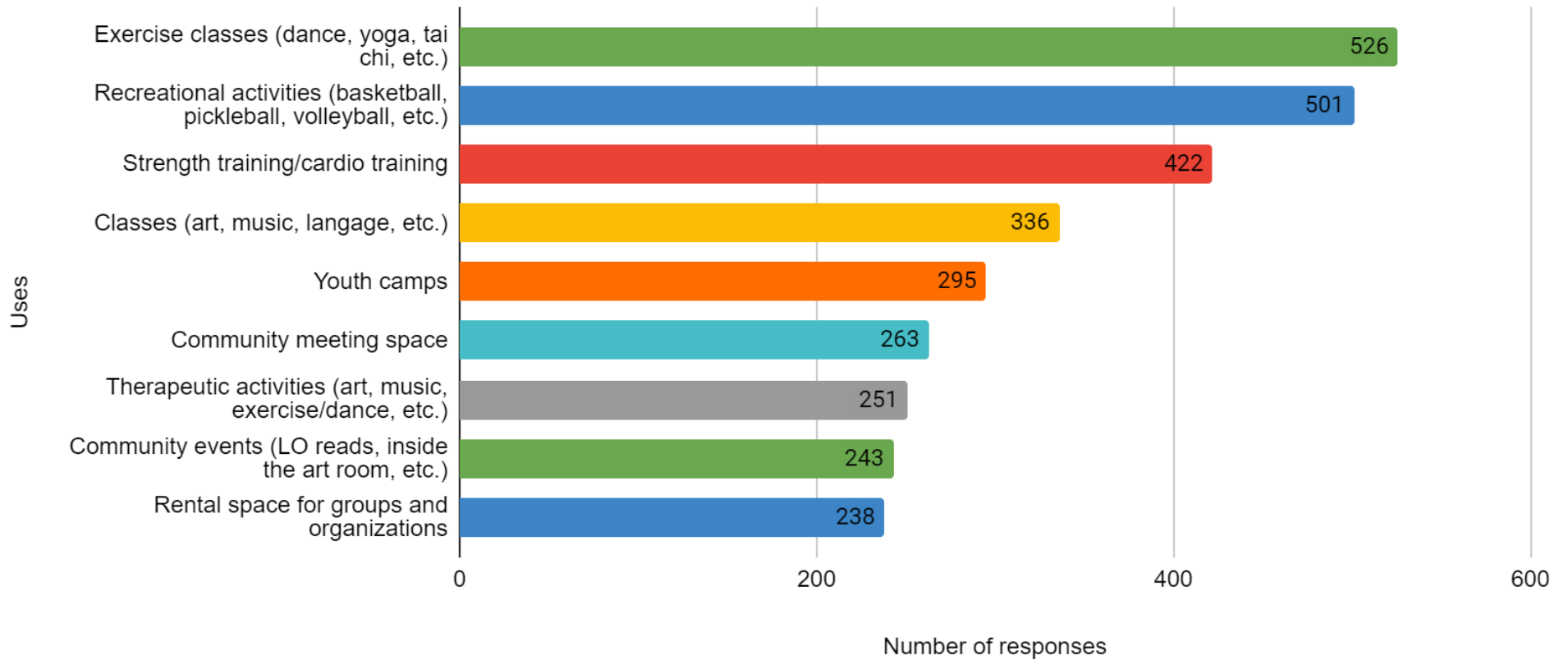

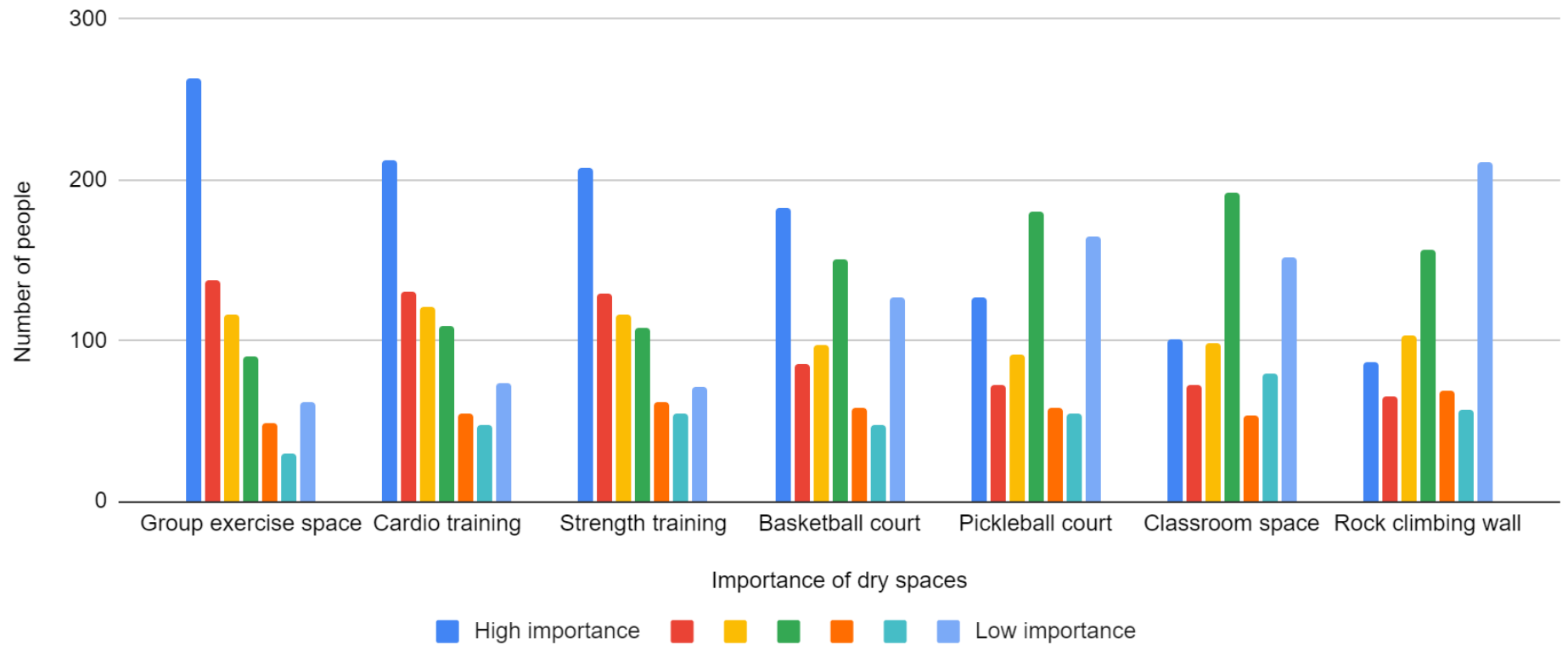
If you have youth in your household, which age group(s) best describe them? Select all that apply.



# What uses would you like to see on the dry side of the recreational center? Select all that apply.

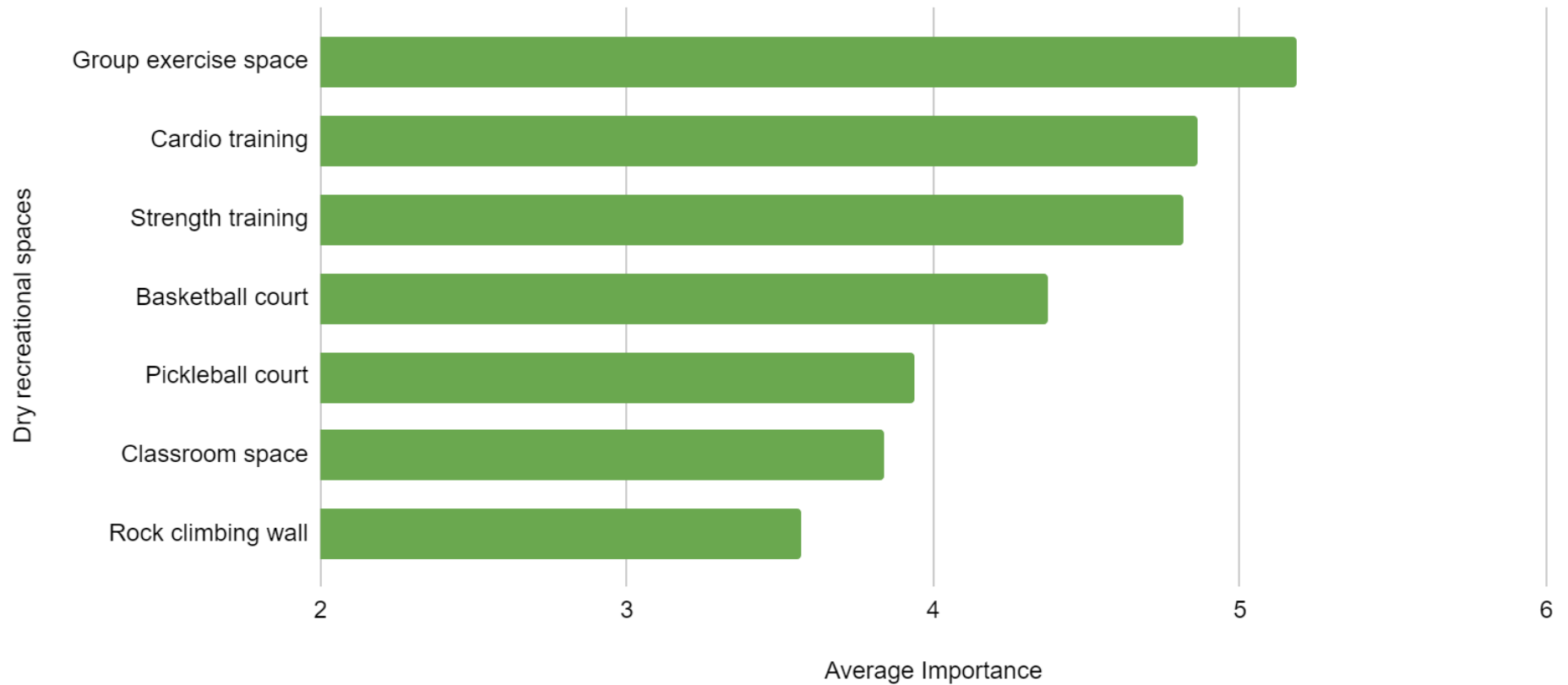


# To what extent do you feel that the following dry spaces are important to include in the recreation center?

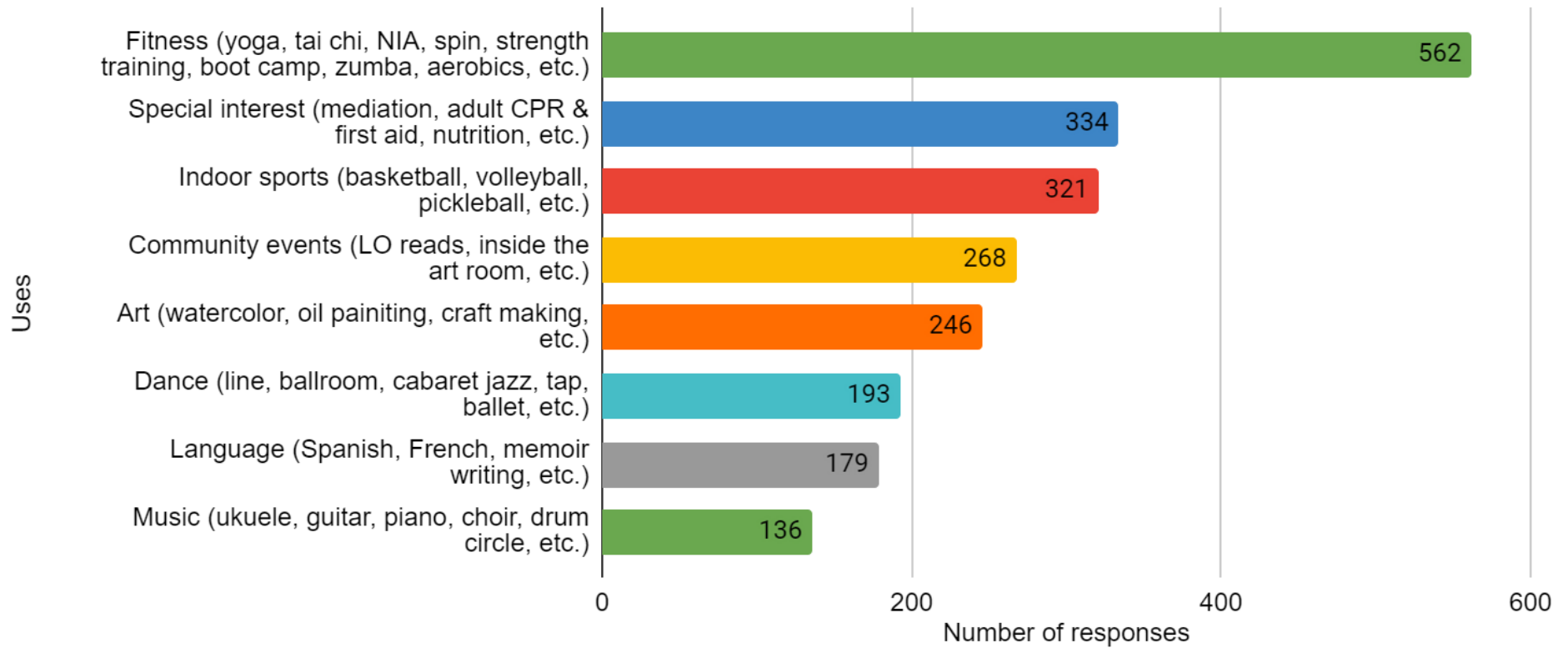




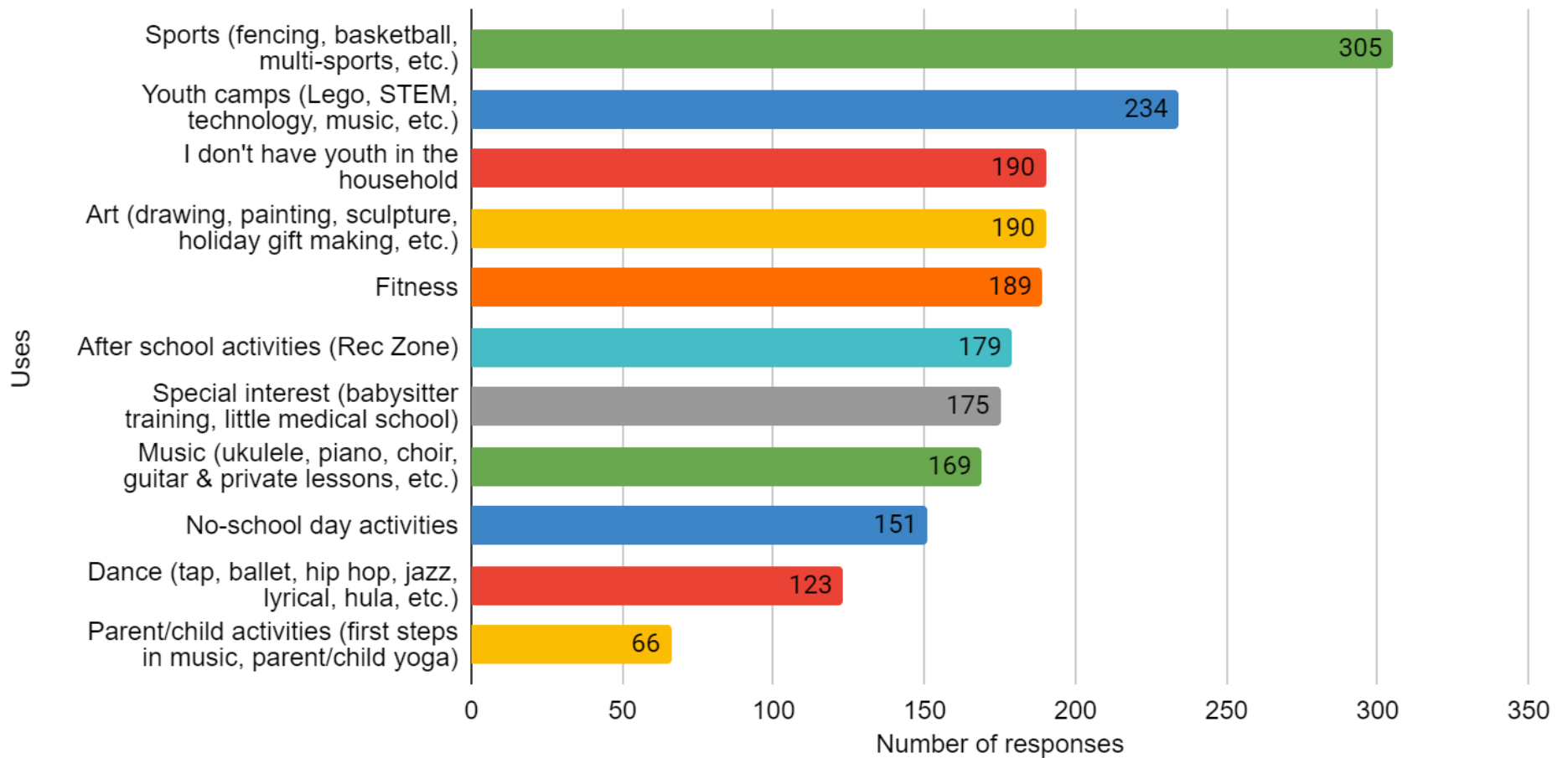
# To what extent do you feel that the following dry spaces are important to include in the recreation center?



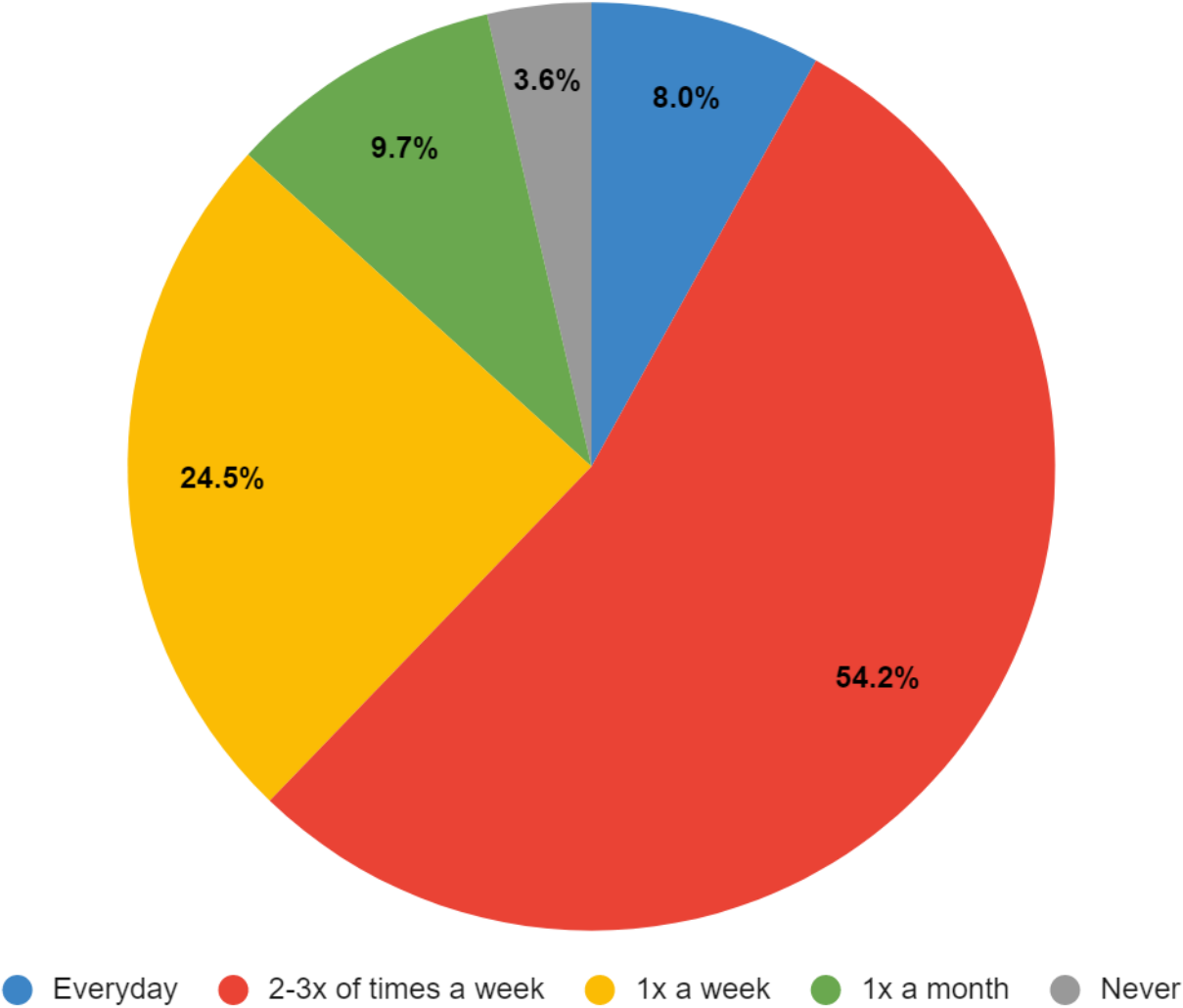
If you are an adult, what classes/activities would you participate in post-pandemic? Select all that apply.



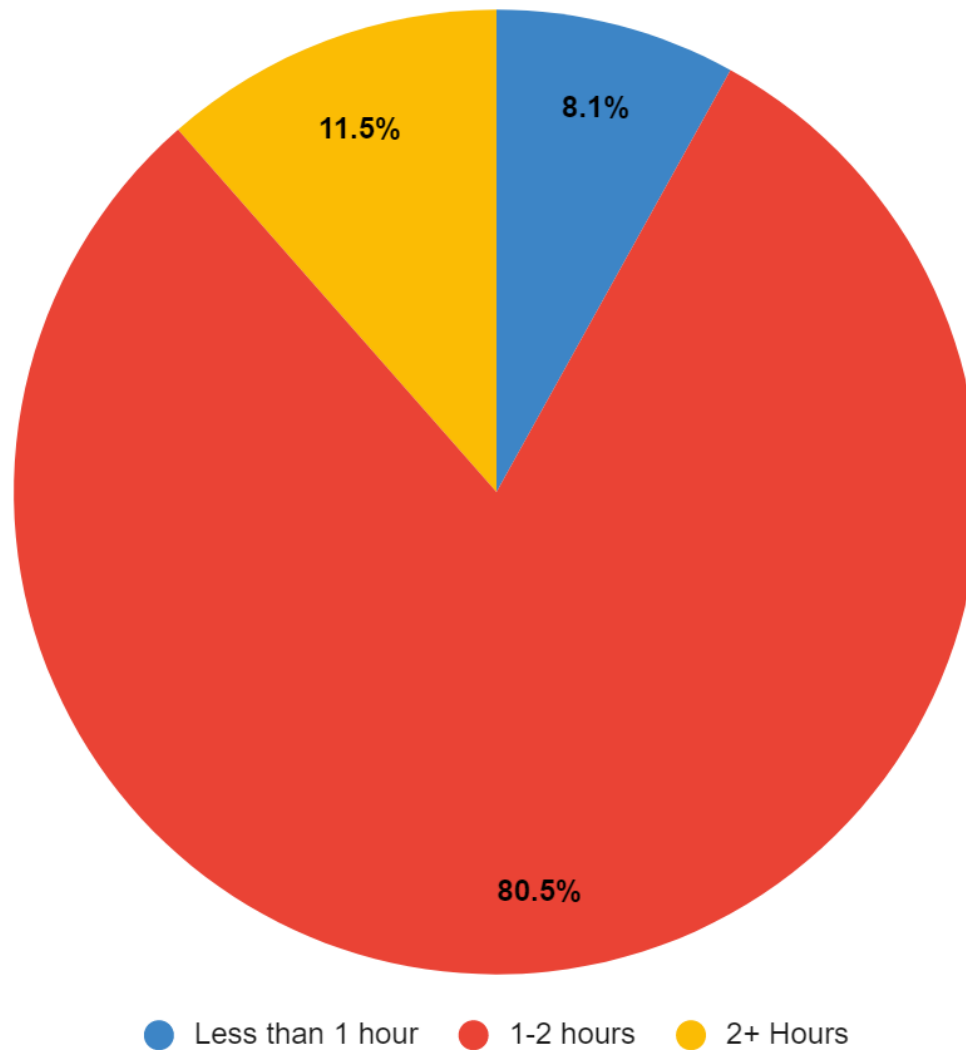
If you are youth or have youth in your household, what classes/activities would you/they participate in post-pandemic? Select all that apply.



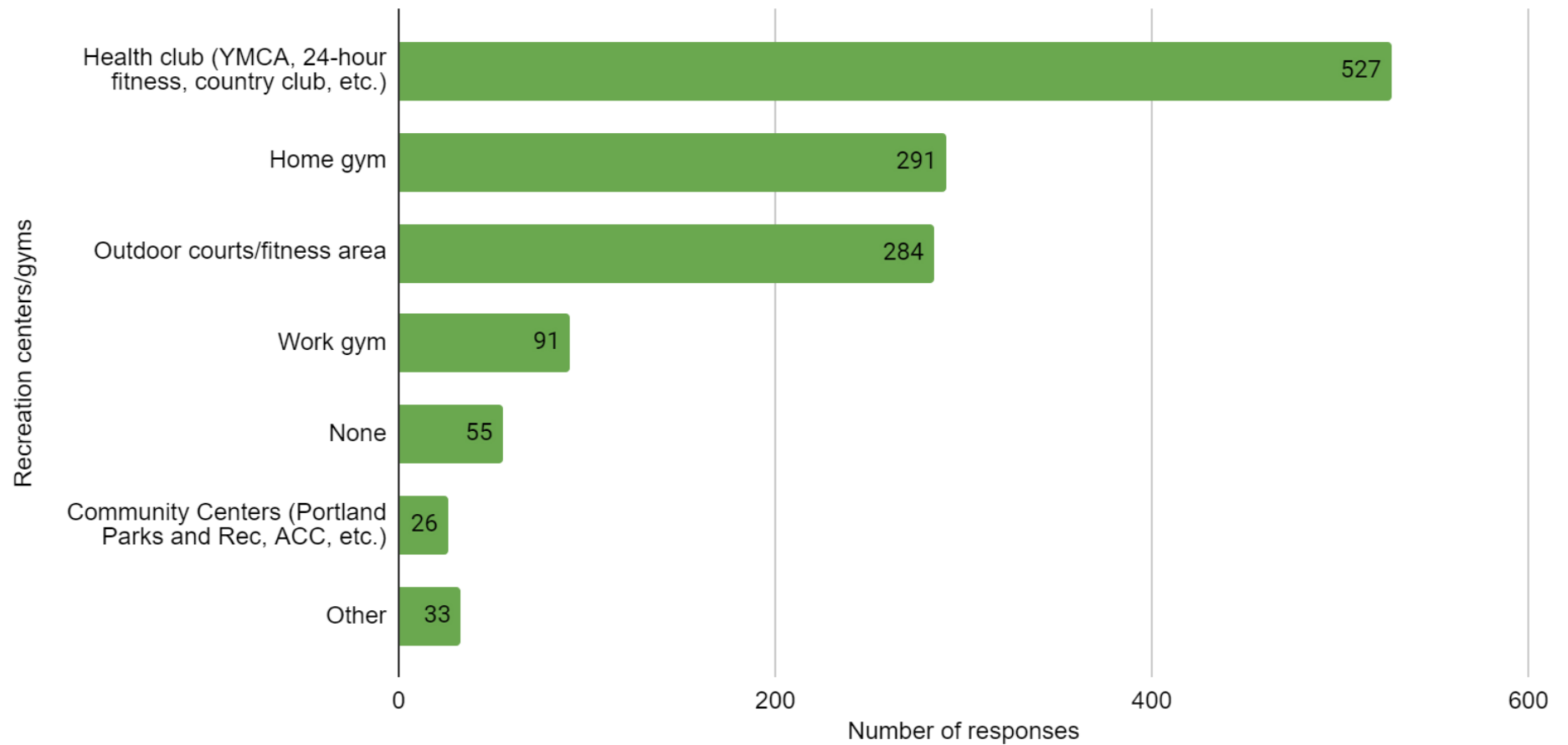
If the dry side of the recreational center has the amenities that you desire, how often would you see your household using the recreation center post-pandemic?



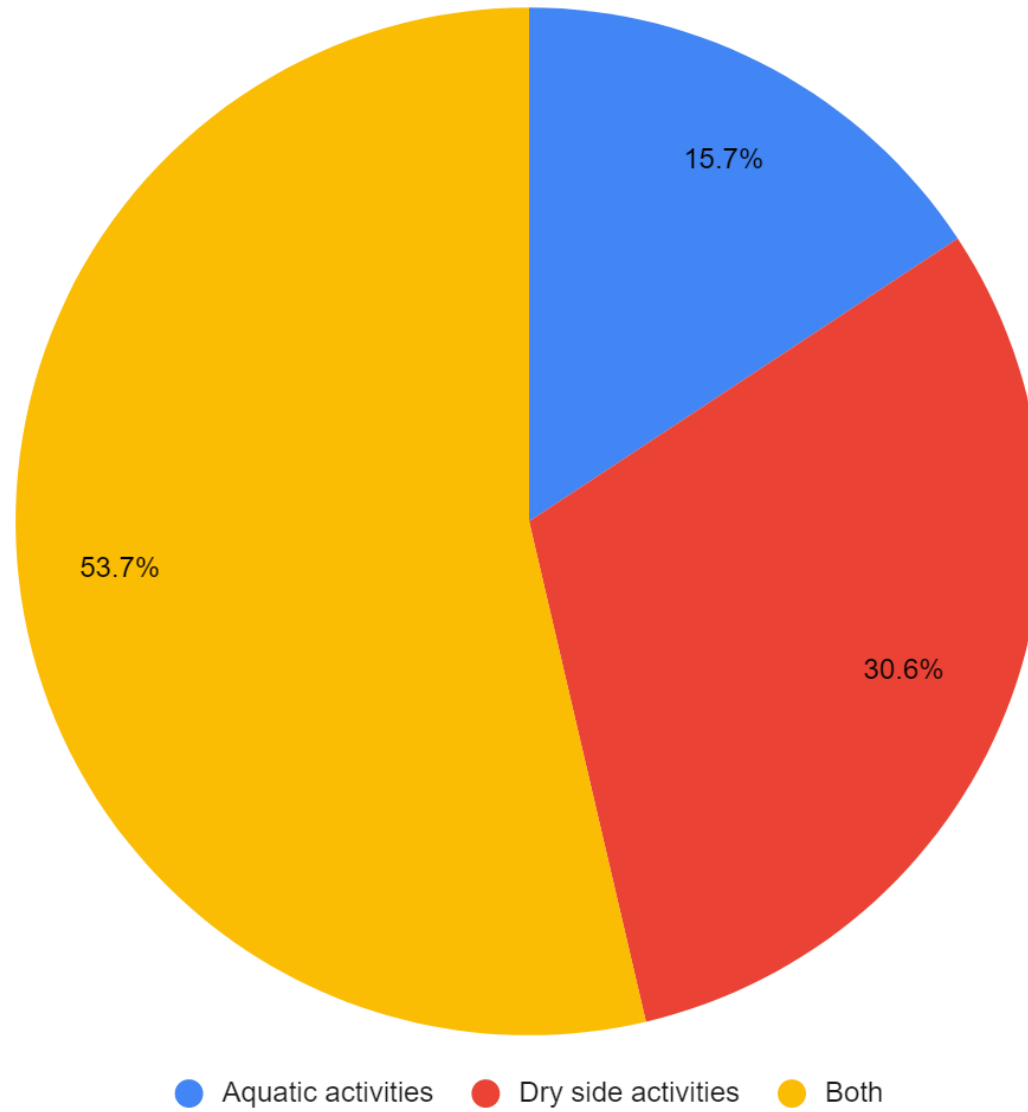
If the dry side of the recreation center had amenities that you desire, how many hours will you and/or your family spend at the dry side of the recreation center during each visit post- pandemic?
