LAKE OSWEGO TO HOLD OPEN HOUSE ON WATER PARTNERSHIP WITH TIGARD

LAKE OSWEGO – The City of Lake Oswego will hold an Open House on Thursday, July 24, 2008 from 7 to 8:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers at City Hall, 380 A Avenue, Lake Oswego. You are invited to a presentation and opportunity to review and comment on options that are being explored to replace and expand our aging water system so that it can continue to supply residents with high quality water in adequate quantities for decades to come.

The Open House is an opportunity for Lake Oswego water customers to learn about a potential joint water supply partnership with the City of Tigard, conservation, and the City's water rights on the Clackamas River. Information on the water partnership will be presented through a video, displays, and handouts. Staff and elected officials will be on hand to discuss these topics and respond to questions. Open House attendees are encouraged to share their thoughts on the future of the water supply system.

The City Council is scheduled to make a final decision on the Joint Water Supply Agreement at their regular meeting on August 5, 2008.

The City of Lake Oswego supplies water to more than 37,000 customers within Lake Oswego including wholesale water customers like the cities of Tigard and Portland, and the Lake Grove, Glenmorrie, and Skylands Water Districts.
