ROAD CLOSURES SCHEDULED FRIDAY AFTERNOON FOR LAKERIDGE HOMECOMING PARADE

LAKE OSWEGO – Lakeridge High School will be celebrating its homecoming on Friday, October 10. A parade is included in this celebration and will take place that afternoon. Although the City will try to keep traffic moving efficiently, there may be some minimal delays. In addition, the following road closures will be in effect:

- Chandler Road, between Iron Mountain and 10th Street, will be closed from approximately 1:00 to 2:00 p.m.
- 10th Street, from Evergreen Road to A Avenue, will be closed from approximately 1:00 to 2:00 p.m. Floats and students will staging on both Chandler and 10th Street in these closed off areas.
- There will be no southbound turns onto 10th Street from A Avenue while the streets are closed. Cars will still be able to turn northbound onto 10th Street from A Avenue.
- Both lanes of eastbound A Avenue will be closed from 2:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.
- Both westbound and eastbound lanes of A Avenue will be closed at 1st Street for about 10 minutes as the parade finishes. Floats will turn northbound onto 1st Street while pedestrians, band members, cheerleaders, and other parade participants turn southbound onto 1st Street.

Buses will be parked along Evergreen Road and 4th Street to return students to school. In addition, along Evergreen, students will be walking back to their cars after the parade.

To help keep the parade running smoothly, Lake Oswego Police Officers and Community Service Officers will be assisting with traffic control during the entire event.
