Lake Oswego Parks & Recreation (LOPR) has established goals and action plans in the 2.5 LOPR Strategic Profile, 2.5.A LOPR_Recreation Strategic Plan and 2.5.B LOPR_Parks Strategic Plan. Each of these three-year plans links department and division specific goals to the goals stated in ParksPlan 2025, the City Comprehensive Plan and Statewide Goal 8 related to recreation.

The success of achieving the goals is based upon the completion of the stated actions in each plan during the defined three-year period.

Council Initiatives

- Guide delivery of Parks Capital Projects, including the LORAC, Golf Course Construction, Rassekh Park, and planned trail projects.
- Adopt a Natural Areas Habitat Management Plan.
- Adopt a new IGA with the Lake Oswego School District for fields and facilities.
- Create a holistic approach to overall health and well-being for our community, similar to a Blue Zones process. Engage City departments, businesses, LOSD, the faith community, and non-profits to create a coordinated effort at improving and maintaining healthy lifestyles
