Title of Document: 2.10 LOPR_ADA Transition Plan

To make Lake Oswego more accessible to all, the City finalized the Americans with Disabilities Act Self-Evaluation and Transition Plan (SETP) (the Plan) with Resolution 22-37 on December 20, 2022. The Plan guides the City in making Lake Oswego's facilities, parks, programs, facilities, and public right-of-way accessible to all, including people with disabilities.

The project includes four major components:

- Evaluating the accessibility of City facilities (buildings, parks, and parking lots);
- Assessing facilities in the public right-of-way; and
- Developing a strategic plan and tools for implementing the recommended changes to City facilities and practices.

The ADA SETP demonstrates the City of Lake Oswego's commitment to providing equal access to its public programs, services, facilities, and activities for citizens with disabilities. The resulting Plan will ensure the City is meeting the requirements of the ADA legislation for Title II entities by:

- Providing notice of nondiscrimination;
- Establishing an ADA grievance procedure;
- Designating an employee responsible for overseeing title II compliance;
- Completing a self-evaluation of services, policies, and practices;
- Developing a transition plan that identifies structural modifications necessary for compliance; and
- Including people with disabilities in the planning process by establishing an ADA stakeholder advisory group
