**Title of Document:** 2.4 LOPR\_Park and Recreation System Master Plan

**Background:**

Parks Plan 2025 (PP2025) was formally adopted July 31, 2012 by Resolution 12-44 (Appendix M page 121 of the plan) and provides the 15 year plan for Lake Oswego Parks & Recreation (LOPR). PP2025 contains recommendations for the provision of recreation facilities, programs and services, parkland acquisition and development, maintenance and operations, and administration and management. The plan is currently scheduled for review in 2023-2024 to be revised and updated to what will become Parks Plan 2040.

PP2025 was developed using a 4 stage planning process as seen in the diagram below.

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## PARKS & RECREATION
