Title of Document: 2.8 LOPR_Historical, Cultural Resource Mgmt Plans

Background:

The 2013 City Comprehensive Plan adopted in 2014 made changes to the previous 1994 plan. The 1994 plan had addressed historic preservation in Goal 5, Section 8, Historic and Cultural Resources.

In the 2013 plan, certain sections were created or modified to better address statewide land use planning goals. The Historic Preservation section (starting on page 46) in Vol I, implements Statewide Planning Goal 5, Open Spaces, Historic & Natural Areas (Historic Areas).

Open Spaces & Natural Areas elements from the 1994 plan that also address Goal 5 were carried forward to the 2013 plan as is. These can be found in Volume II, beginning on page 181 of the document.

Document 2.8.A is the Historic Preservation section excerpt from the 2013 Comprehensive Plan that provides the history, past actions, issues, goals and policies, and recommended actions to address historical and cultural resource preservation.

The Historic Resources Advisory Board (HRAB) is an eight-member citizen advisory body, including one youth member, appointed by the City Council. It meets to promote and foster the historic, educational, architectural, cultural, economic, and general welfare of the public through the identification, preservation, restoration, and protection of those structures, sites, objects, and districts of historic and cultural interest within the city.
