Team Formation & Player Eligibility

Players, Student Managers and/or Adult Managers form their own team within the guidelines stated below. The league is open to girls and boys in the 9th, 10th, 11th, and 12th grades, ***within the following guidelines:***

- All participants must currently be a high school student attending a Lake Oswego 7J School District High School &/or residing within the Lake Oswego School District or City of Lake Oswego boundaries.
- A minimum of 8 eligible players is required and a maximum of 15 players are allowed per roster.
- This recreational league is only open to players who are **NOT** selected for their 2022/2023 high school basketball team (Varsity, JV & Freshman teams).

Registration and Fees

- Team registration format, individuals are not placed on teams. Register at www.loparks.org. Managers must first create their team before players can register. With the registration system, the parent/guardian should set up a family account and add the student manager/player onto the account. Players need to know team name and division name to register.
- Registration Fee: **\$150 per player fee**, pay when you register (includes team T-shirts). Deadline to have a minimum of 8 players registered to get your team in the league is Tuesday, Nov. 8.
- **Scholarships:** L.O. Parks & Recreation offers a limited number of partial scholarships for City and School District residents needing financial assistance. For more information contact Dina Balogh at dbalogh@lakeoswego.city or 503-534-5420

Adult Team Supervisors

- All teams are required to have at least **one (1)** registered Adult Supervisors. There is no limit to how many registered Adult Supervisors a team can have.
- Volunteer Adult Supervisor are registered City Volunteers with the Parks & Recreation Department. There are two required forms:
 1. Criminal Background/Records Check Form
 2. City of L.O. Volunteer Agreement and Release Form

- For the 2022/23 season, ***H.S. City League teams are not required to have a registered Volunteer Adult Supervisor on the bench during the game.*** Teams can have a registered Adult Supervisor sit on the bench.
- Both Adult Supervisor forms are due by **11/8/22**

Important Dates for the 2022/2023 season

- **November 8**
 - **REGISTRATION & FORMS DEADLINE**
 - A minimum of 8 players must be registered to guarantee participation in this league. Register at www.loparks.org
 - Shirt order form (and team name selection) must be completed online.
 - Two required forms for a minimum of one **(1) Adult Supervisor** form due, to L.O. Parks & Recreation by:
 - Scanning to sportsforms@lakeoswego.city OR brought to L.O. Parks & Recreation front desk at the Adult Community Center (505 G Ave, M-F, 8am-4:30pm)
 - Forms are available at www.lakeoswegosports.com under the High School Basketball Leagues page.
- **November 18:** Game schedule posted at www.lakeoswegosports.com
- **November 29 - 30:** Team uniform shirt distribution at High Schools
- **December 1 – December 2:** League games begin
- **December 11:**
 - Last day to add players to your roster;
 - **Late Add player fee:** \$160 per player. Players registering after 11/8 pay a late add fee of \$10.
 - **Uniform T-Shirts:** Any player added after 11/8 must wait for their shirt to arrive before they are eligible to play
 - Late Add uniform shirts can take up to 2 weeks after registering
- **Weekend of February 25/26: Championship Games!**
