RE WO 273 – Jean/Pilkington Intersection Improvements

Dear Neighbor:

Based on intersection analysis done throughout the City in late 2017, The City has identified the Jean and Pilkington Road intersection as operationally sub-standard. The City recently hired a consultant team to evaluate potential solutions for this intersection. This intersection improvement project is identified as an important component in the City's Transportation System Plan (TSP) and is funded under the current Capital Improvement Plan (CIP).

The consultants were asked to compare a traffic signal versus roundabout and develop conceptual level plans and cost estimate for each. The comparison showed that while both alternatives would initially cost about the same, the impact of each alternative was quite different. Specifically, the area or footprint needed for a roundabout is greater than what is needed for a traditional signal installation. After careful evaluation, the Engineering Department is recommending a signal for the Jean and Pilkington intersection. A signal will address sub-standard performance and improve pedestrian safety. It also keeps with the current feel of the neighborhood by minimizing impacts to adjacent properties.

The City is committed to working with Rosewood and Bryant Neighborhoods to gather input and concerns to help inform the design. Due to Covid-19 restrictions, the City will be presenting this meeting via Webex only.
