

RESOLUTION 16-10

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKE OSWEGO SUPPORTING AN APPLICATION FOR A LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND GRANT FOR THE DEVELOPMENT AND RESTORATION OF IRON MOUNTAIN PARK

WHEREAS, the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department is accepting applications for the federal Land and Water Conservation Fund Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lake Oswego desires to participate in this grant program to the greatest extent possible as a means of providing needed park and recreation acquisition, improvements and enhancements; and

WHEREAS, City Council and staff have identified natural park amenity improvements at Iron Mountain Park as a high priority need in Lake Oswego; and

WHEREAS, Park amenities have been identified through the Iron Mountain Park Master Plan process and resource restoration; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lake Oswego has available local matching funds from Park System Development Charges to fulfill its share of obligations related to this grant application should the grant funds be awarded; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lake Oswego has estimated that annual maintenance costs will be \$74,400, and will dedicate adequate funding for on-going operations and maintenance of this park and recreation facility should the grant funds be awarded; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lake Oswego that:

Section 1: The City Council supports the submittal of a grant application to the Oregon Park and Recreation Department for development and rehabilitation of Iron Mountain Park.

Section 2: This Resolution shall be effective upon its adoption by the City Council.


