

RESOLUTION 17-20

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKE OSWEGO SUPPORTING AN APPLICATION FOR A LOCAL GOVERNMENT GRANT FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF IRON MOUNTAIN PARK

WHEREAS, the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department is accepting applications for the Local Government Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lake Oswego desires to participate in this grant program to the greatest extent possible as a means to provide needed park and recreation acquisition, improvements and enhancements; and

WHEREAS, the City Council and staff have identified natural park amenity improvements at Iron Mountain as a high priority need in Lake Oswego; and

WHEREAS, Park improvements have been identified through the Iron Mountain Park Master Plan process; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lake Oswego has available local matching funds from Parks System Development Charges to fulfill its share of obligations related to this grant application; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lake Oswego has estimated the annual maintenance costs will be \$74,400, and will dedicate adequate funding for on-going operations and maintenance of this park and recreation facility should grant funds be awarded; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lake Oswego that:

Section1: The City Council supports the submittal of a grant application to the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department for development of Iron Mountain Park.


Section 2: This resolution shall be effective upon its adoption by City Council.


