FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is a bookmobile?

A bookmobile is a library on wheels. It brings materials, technology, helpful library staff, and other services directly into neighborhoods. Lake Oswego Public Library's bookmobile is named *Rover*. Rover travels around the City and to unincorporated areas of the Library's service district to offer convenient, welcoming, and accessible connection to library services.

How can I use Rover the bookmobile?

- Browse and check out popular titles for every age
- Pick up holds and return materials
- Sign up for a LINCC library card
- Get help with digital resources and access free WiFi
- Receive personalized recommendations from librarians

When will Rover be in my neighborhood?

Is the bookmobile ADA accessible?

Rover the bookmobile is ADA accessible and designed to welcome all visitors.

- Ramp for smooth entry and easy walk-on to the main browsing area
- Accessible formats and technology

Will a visit to Rover the bookmobile cost anything?

There is no cost, all Library services are completely free.

- No late fees on materials checked out from Rover

What can I borrow from Rover the bookmobile?

- Books, audiobooks, movies – something for everyone to enjoy
- Items from the Library of Things and Seed packets from our mobile Seed Library
- Reserve a cultural pass and get help with digital resources

Who can use Rover the bookmobile?

Everyone is welcome! Rover is free and open to all ages, and you don't need a library card to visit.

- Residents: Anyone living in the Library's service area, including residents of Clackamas, Multnomah, or Washington counties can check out materials with a LINCC library card.
- Visitors without a library card: You can browse, use Wi-Fi, and join activities.
- Temporary or new library cards: If you don't have ID or proof of address, we can give you a temporary card so you can borrow items and place holds.

How many items can I check out on the bookmobile?

Full service LINCC library card holders may have up to 80 items checked out and 40 active holds placed at a time. Temporary cards are available so everyone can borrow books and other materials, even on a first visit.

Can I pick up holds on the bookmobile?

When placing a hold, choose "Lake Oswego Bookmobile" as your pickup location. Once your items are ready, visit a Bookmobile stop that is open to the public to pick them up. You will have four weeks to pick up your items.

Who can get a library card?

Anyone living in the Library's service area including residents of Clackamas, Multnomah, or Washington counties can get a free LINCC library card, with a government-issued photo ID and proof of current address.

No ID or proof of address? We can issue a temporary library card that lets you check out 5 items and place 5 active holds.

Forgot your card or not sure if you have one? We can look up your account with your photo ID.
