The Budget Committee is the fiscal planning board of the City. It consists of the governing body (City Council) and an equal number of legal voters (citizen members of the Budget Committee) appointed by the Council. Lake Oswego therefore has 14 committee members, and the votes of all the members are equal. State law (ORS 294.336) mandates a budget committee for all Oregon local governments.

The Proposed Budget will be published on or before April 19, 2018. This is public meeting where any person may appear for public comment.

Budget Committee Meetings and Members

In the Spring of each year, the Budget Committee meets to review the proposed budget rendered by the City Budget Officer (in Lake Oswego, this is the City Manager). The meetings are open to the public and input from the public is received at the meetings. The committee may approve the proposed budget intact, or change part or all of it prior to final approval. After the Budget Committee reviews and recommends changes, if any, and notices and publications are filed according to law, the budget is forwarded to the Council, where a public hearing is held before formal adoption prior to

June 30. Council can adopt the budget as approved or vote on changes prior to adoption.

The fiscal powers of the Budget Committee are:

- Specify the amount of property tax revenue and/or tax rates
- Establish maximum total expenditures for each fund
- Approve the total property taxes levied as an amount and/or rate
- Approve the budget for adoption by the City Council

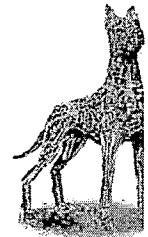

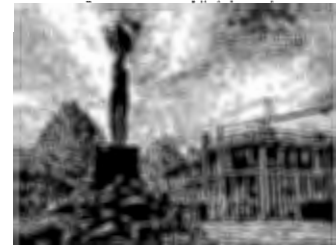

LORA - Urban Renewal Budget



The Lake Oswego Redevelopment Agency's 2017-18 Adopted Budget, is available online and account information is also provided below (see attachments at the bottom of this page).

The urban renewal agency for the City of Lake Oswego is known as LORA, the **Lake Oswego Redevelopment Agency**. LORA was organized Nov. 6, 1979 under provisions of the Oregon Revised Statutes, Chapter 457, to undertake urban renewal projects and activities pursuant to the East End Redevelopment Plan. The plan was adopted by the City Council on Sept. 19, 1986.

The Lake Oswego Redevelopment Agency (LORA) is an urban renewal that is a component unit of the City of Lake Oswego and adopts a budget that is basically the financial plan for the Agency. It forms the basis for budget appropriations and includes any revisions or adjustments made by the Budget Committee.

The City and LORA Budget Committees have the same members - seven elected members and seven non-elected citizens. The budget is balanced and funds the continuation of most of the Agency's core services. Additional account breakdown is provided in the attachment below this page.

The following are significant steps in a budget process:

- April 2018 – The LORA's Proposed Budget is completed. This represents the first official step in the process and provides a starting point for discussions.
- The Budget Committee meets for public review and consideration of the document. The Budget Committee deliberates on the Proposed Budget and approve the budget, for recommendation to LORA's board.
- June 5, 2018 – The Adopted Budget. LORA's board members reviews and considers the Approved Budget, deliberates and, where they determine appropriate, makes further adjustments that are embodied into the Adopted Budget.
- July 1 – Implementation of the FY 2018-19 budget. Any changes in services within the Adopted Budget are implemented.

Any citizen who is interested in reviewing the budget may contact the Finance Department at City Hall. Copies of previous years' adopted budgets are also available for review at the Lake Oswego Public Library and online.

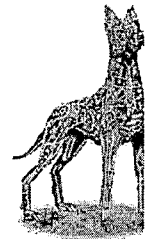
