Hello Friends of Lake Oswego Parks and Recreation,

Today, based on Governor Brown's Executive Order we've made the decision to CLOSE the following Lake Oswego Parks and Recreation facilities;

- Athletic Fields
- Sports Courts
- Dog Parks
- Luscher Farm (Community Gardens, Friends of Rogerson Clematis Garden)
- Playgrounds
- Public Golf Course
- Restrooms
- Water Sports Center

In addition to the facility closures we are closing park and natural area parking lots.

Lake Oswego Parks and Recreation parks, trails, and natural areas remain open to the public for walk-in use only. Please obey notices in parks. Food security programs will remain open, Meals on Wheels and Community Supported Agriculture (CSA). We are committed to continue serving our community during this public health crisis, but we will continue to follow the guidance of health officials and the direction of State and city government.

1. Refrain from using parks or trails if you are exhibiting symptoms. **(Feel Sick, Stay Home)**
2. Follow CDC's guidance on personal hygiene prior to, during, and after use of parks or trails. **(Wash Your Hands, Don't Touch Your Face)**
3. Restrooms and drinking fountains are closed. **(All Restrooms Will Be Closed, Be Prepared)**
4. While on trails, warn other users of their presence and as they pass, and step aside to let others pass. **(Give Other Users Respect and Space)**
5. Observe CDC's minimum recommended social distancing of 6 feet from other individuals at all times. If this is not possible, users should find an alternate location or find another space. **(Move To Find Your Own Space)**

Based on the guidance of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, the Oregon Health Authority, and local health officials, LOPR indoor facilities (Golf Clubhouse, Tennis Center, CCP, Adult Community

Center) will remain closed through April 28, 2020 (subject to change). Additionally all LOPR activities are canceled through April 28, 2020.
