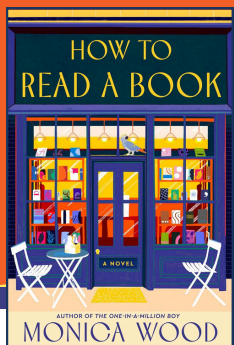


Lake Oswego Reads 2025

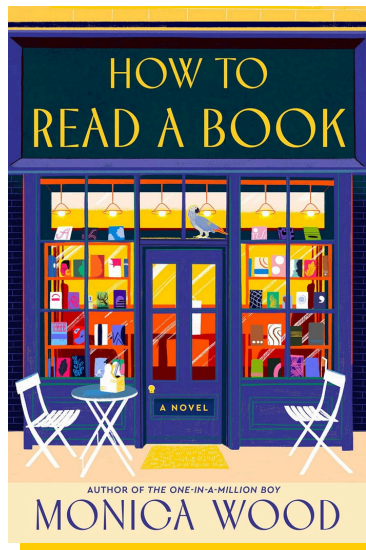
