Pedestrian Safety Enforcement Detail

The Lake Oswego Police Department conducted a Pedestrian Safety Enforcement (PSE) detail on July 16, 2018, between 0800 and 1700 at the intersection of B Avenue and 2nd Street. The PSE detail was conducted at no cost to the City and paid for with funds received from a traffic safety grant issued by Oregon Impact to promote pedestrian awareness and safety as well as driver awareness and safety. This is the ninth annual award the Lake Oswego Police Department has received.

The location was selected due to a number of factors:

1. A fatal pedestrian crash at the unmarked crosswalk at 3rd Street and B Avenue in 2017.
2. The number of complaints of drivers not stopping for pedestrians in the crosswalk.
3. The safety of the officers involved in the detail due to the 20 mph speed limit on B Avenue.

A total of 52 citations were issued. One more than the 51 citations issued in the PSE 2017 detail. Listed are the specific violations in which a driver, bicyclist or pedestrian had been contacted and the result of the contact.
