Dear Lunch2Go Participant,

We hope that you found creative ways to celebrate the Thanksgiving holiday.

The Lunch2Go program will resume on Monday, December 7th. The Lake Oswego Adult Community Center (LOACC) has been committed to you and our staff by establishing a safe way to provide meals from a distance.

Given that Clackamas County falls into the extreme risk category under the new framework outlined by the State of Oregon, we will be enhancing our safety procedures in order to keep both our participants and staff safe and healthy. Please note the following:

- When you pull up to receive your lunch, simply pop open the trunk of your vehicle and we will place your lunch in the back.
- If you choose to get out of your vehicle, we will place your meal on the sanitized table and take a step back so that you can take your meal. Staff will not be handling your reusable bag.
- If you are donating with cash, we will provide a box for you to drop in the money.
- No change will be given. If you have a larger bill, you can either donate the balance or move the balance to future meals.

As per prior procedures, give the LOACC a call 24 hours in advance to reserve your lunch and stay home if you are not feeling well. Thank you in advance for following the enhanced procedures. It is important that we keep all involved healthy.
