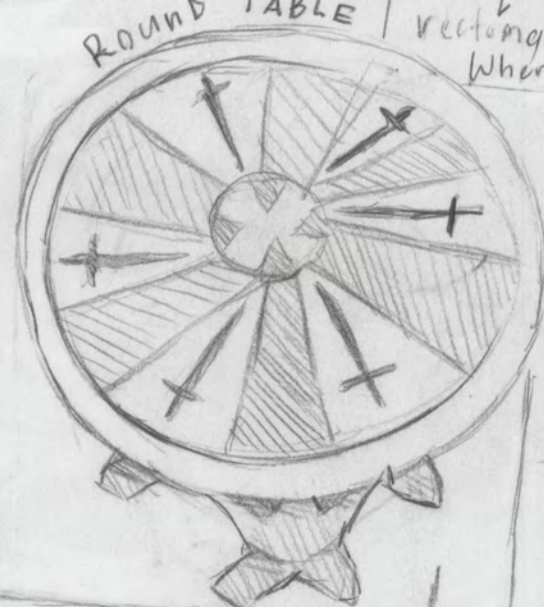
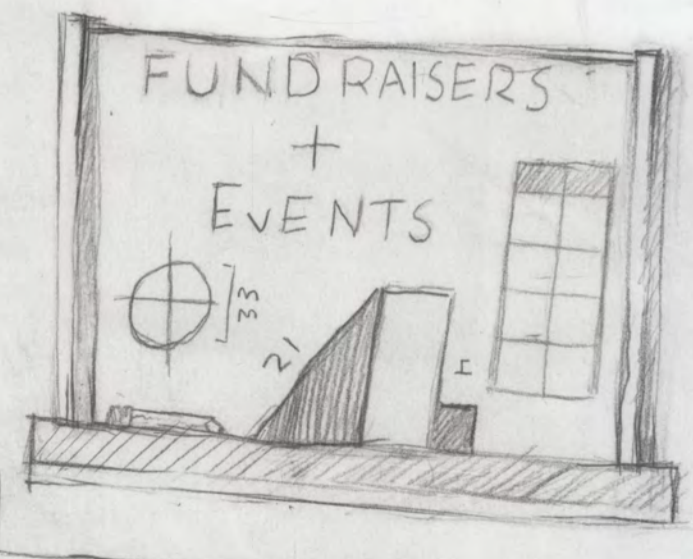
THIS certain tree, when watered, has enough sunshine, and enough love, produces fruit that can heal every injury. But if it does not have those things, these fruits can be very deadly.
