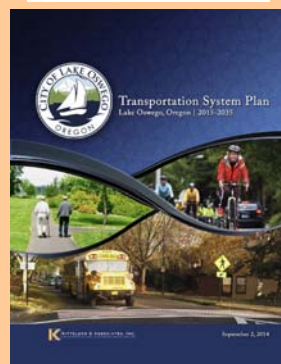
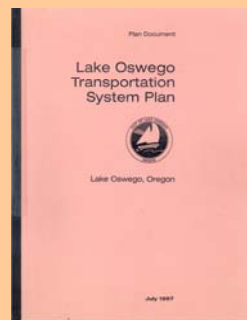

## What is the TSP?

- A planning document that identifies transportation system needs and performance measures for the City's transportation network
- A component of the City's Comprehensive Plan



## Comprehensive Plan, TSP and the CIP one informs the other



## Purpose of the TSP

### Planning

- Required by State of Oregon
- Contains TSP components typical for a city our size
- Supports coordinated planning before growth occurs

### Engineering

- Informs the CIP (Capital Improvement Plan)
- Establishes eligibility for funding
- Guides improvements associated with development
- Ensures consistency in design & construction

## BACKGROUND

- The TSP was updated in 2014
- Recommended amendments are the result of a 2015 audit of the CDC, TSP and Comp Plan to ensure consistency among the three documents
- Recently adopted Southwest Employment Area Plan includes street projects to be added to TSP

## Summary of Changes

- Comprehensive Plan
  - Updated intro paragraph of ‘Connected Community’
  - Specifies intersection Level of Service, as in previous Comp Plan
  - Updated functional street classification map (2 roads)
- TSP
  - Specifies intersection Level of Service, matching Comp Plan
  - SWEA roadway projects incorporated

## Summary of Changes

- Community Development Code
  - Clarifies use of “traffic impact study”
  - Details triggers for a traffic impact study
  - Driveway spacing requirements to coincide with those in TSP
  - Corrects a reference to Metro Code
  - Requires posting sign for future street extensions
  - Clarifies public notice to transportation authorities
  - Adds definitions

## Summary of Changes

- Traffic Impact Study (TIS) Guidelines
  - Aligns with current engineering practice for development applications
  - Further procedures for analysis provided
  - Document is flexible to conform to the characteristics of a particular development
  - Includes general outline for TIS
