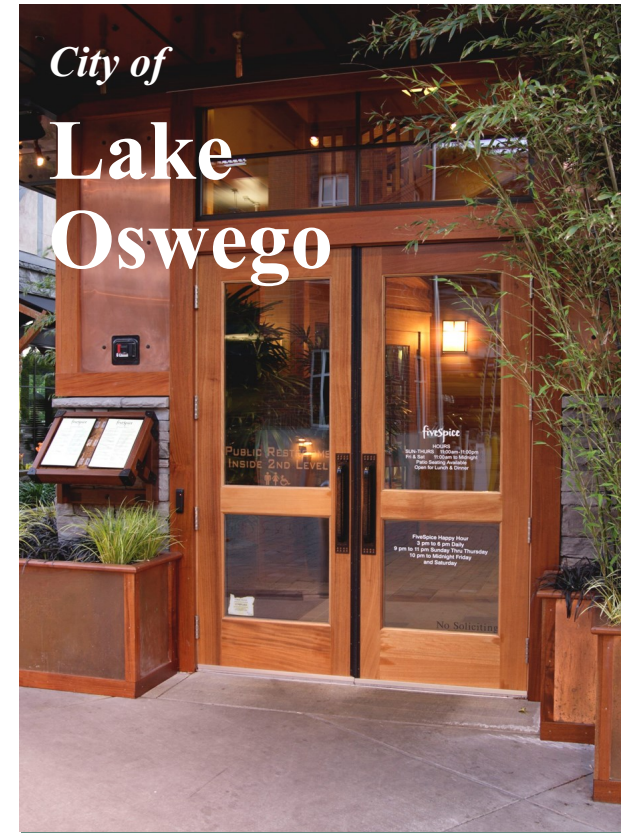

Who needs a City of Lake Oswego business license?

Lake Oswego Ordinance 20.02.025 requires that anyone conducting business within the City of Lake Oswego must first obtain a business license, unless specifically exempted by State law (*Real Estate Agents, Insurance Agents*).

Does the license cover door-to-door solicitation?

Yes. Please register solicitors at the third floor Finance Department Counter at City Hall.

Where should you go to apply for a business license?

Applications are available at the Finance Department on the third floor of City Hall or online at www.lakeoswego.city/finance/getting-business-license.

Submit applications online, by mail, or in person.

How long will it take to get your license?

Applications should be submitted 30 days prior to the date the license is requested to be effective. The review process is normally completed within 10 business days.

How much will it cost?

Current fees for the initial business license application are:

Non-Profit	No fee
Home-Based Businesses	\$100
Short-Term Rental	\$100
1-25 employees (<i>including owners</i>) ...	\$200
26-50 employees (<i>including owners</i>) ..	\$350
51+ employees (<i>including owners</i>)	\$450

What happens after the fees are paid and the application is submitted?

Once submitted, all applications are routed to the Planning Department for review and approval. Planning staff reviews all commercial and home business license applications for compliance with the Zoning Code to ensure that the business is an allowed use in the zone and that adequate parking is available for each business. However, if issues such as health and safety are involved, the review process may also include the Engineering, Fire, and Police Departments.

Once the application has been approved, the license will be mailed to you.



Sign Permits

Permits are required for all new permanent signs, changes to existing permanent signs, and temporary signs such as those that advertise sales and special events. All sign permits are reviewed by the Planning staff for compliance.
