Many families suffer needless loss and injury each year due to fire in their homes. Most of these fires could have been prevented by planning and practicing a **HOME ESCAPE PLAN**.

Lake Oswego Fire Department offers the following advice to help you plan your emergency escape from your home in the event of a fire.

IMPORTANT:

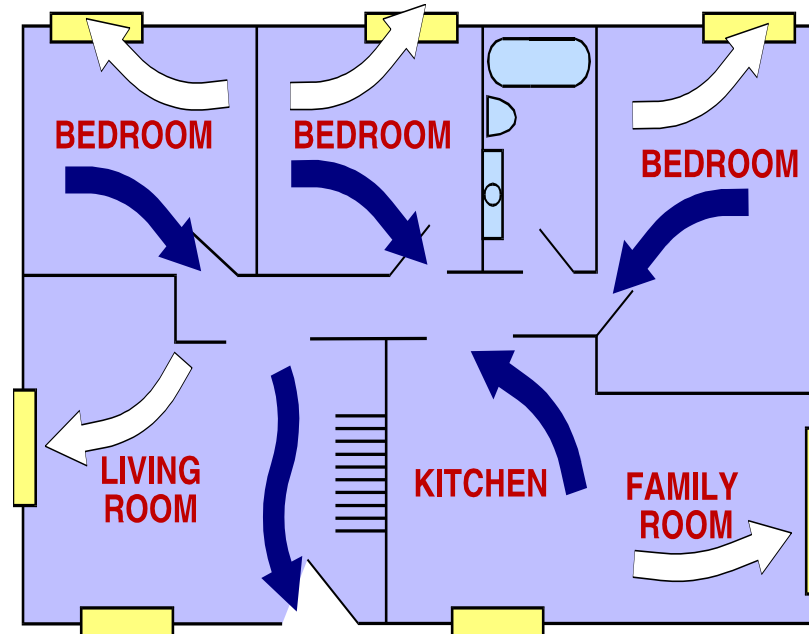
-  Have a working smoke detector on each level of the home
-  Sleep with bedroom doors closed.
-  Provide two escape routes from each bedroom (the door and a window).
-  If you MUST exit through smoke, crawl low to the floor where the air is cooler and less toxic.
-  Designate a meeting place outside—Choose one location for the entire family!!
-  Once outside, do not re-enter the house for any reason including pets or other belongings. From a neighbors home call 9-1-1.

Use the inside of this sheet to draw the floor plan of your home. Show escape routes from each room, especially the bedrooms. (See the example on the back)

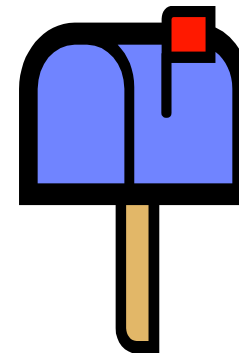
