### **PAC Evaluation Criteria**

#### **Evaluation Questions**

- A. Does the refinement or alignment preference advance the LGVC Plan as stated in the applicable goals and policies?
- B. Does the refinement or alignment provide benefit while balancing and integrating multiple goals/policies?
- C. Will the refinement or alignment address any negative economic impact?
- D. Is the recommended refinement or alignment able to receive financial funding support as a public area improvement and will it help attract priority investment into Lake Grove?

#### **Key Considerations**

- 1. Advance the LGVC Vision - The improvement or alternative would:
  - A. Substantially conform to the concept of a Great Street as described in the Lake Grove Village Center Plan.
  - B. Enhance the safety, mobility, and connectivity for vehicles, pedestrians, and cyclists.
  - C. Enhance aesthetics of the LGVC district and minimize the removal of large trees.
- 2. Promote Sustainability - The improvement or alternative would:
  - A. Protect and restore natural systems.
  - B. Result in opportunities for less vehicle miles traveled and reduced green house gas emissions.
  - C. Provide equitable economic and social benefits throughout the district.
- 3. Result in Achievable Solutions - The improvement or alternative would:
  - A. Minimize and mitigate negative impacts on private commercial property in terms of access, ROW impacts, and parking loss.
  - B. Minimize and mitigate negative impacts on adjoining residential neighborhoods.
  - C. Create a street design that can be constructed at a reasonable cost.
