I would like my written comments to be considered at the hearing for the proposed building of the Goodwill Industries Donation Center and Retail Commercial Building.

I was shocked to see the addition of the 6,416 sq. ft. Retail Commercial Building as an addition to the previously sited 1,057 sq. ft. Goodwill Donation Center. I do not recall that portion in the previous notification concerning the Goodwill development. Perhaps I missed it in the first communication. However, if I had seen it I would have objected then.

I do not think that an industrial, big box type building is at all in keeping with the revival of the Lake Grove area. This end of Lake Oswego was finally starting to look like the rest of the Lake Oswego. With this development it will take it right back down to industrial type left overs.

If both of these buildings are to be built at this location, I hope that the same architectural design rules and regulations will apply to it, as they have to the recent buildings built. It needs to reflect the "new" look of the area and not completely ruin the cohesive look that we were starting to see.
