School Zone Enforcement Detail Conducted by Lake Oswego Police

The Lake Oswego Police Department conducted a School Zone Enforcement detail on Thursday, May 25, 2017. The detail along Boones Ferry Road adjacent to Lake Grove Elementary School started at 3:00 p.m. and finished at 4:00 p.m. This detail was conducted during the posted 20mph school speed designation.

During the hour long operation, a total of 23 citations were issued which include two citations for using a cell phone and one failure to use a seatbelt. The highest speed cited was 41mph and the lowest speed cited was 32mph. The average speed cited was 34mph in the posted 20mph school zone.

We encourage all drivers to please be aware of their speeds in the school zones throughout Lake Oswego. Safety and voluntarily compliance is the police department's goal.

The School Zone Enforcement detail was made possible with funds received from a traffic safety grant designed to promote pedestrian awareness and safety as well as driver awareness and safety from Clackamas County Department of Transportation Traffic Safety.
