Pedestrian Safety Enforcement Detail

The Lake Oswego Police Department in conjunction with the West Linn Police Department, conducted two Pedestrian Safety Enforcement (PSE) details this summer. The first PSE was conducted on Monday, June 30, 2014, between 0800 and 1200 at the intersection of B Avenue and 2nd Street. The second PSE was conducted on Friday, August 15, 2014, between 0800 and 1200, at the intersection of A Avenue and 5th Street. The Pedestrian Safety Enforcement details were conducted with funds received from a traffic safety grant issued by Oregon Impact to promote pedestrian awareness and safety as well as driver awareness and safety.
