## School Zone Enforcement Detail

The Lake Oswego Police Department conducted two School Zone Enforcement details on September 1, 2015. The first detail took place from 0715 to 0830 on Country Club Road in the posted school zone adjacent to Lake Oswego Junior High School and Lake Oswego High School. The second detail took place from 1425 to 1515 on Overlook Drive in the posted school zone adjacent to Lakeridge High School. The School Zone Enforcement detail was conducted with funds received from a traffic safety grant issued to promote pedestrian awareness and safety as well as driver awareness and safety.

The following is a breakdown of the results:

**Lake Oswego Junior High and High School:** A total of 22 citations were written. Nineteen citations for speed with the highest speed being 42 mph and the lowest 32 mph. The average speed cited was 36 mph in the posted 20 mph school zone. In addition, there were 2 citations for using a cell phone while driving and 1 uninsured motorist.

**Lakeridge High School:** A total of 4 citations were issued. One driver was cited for speed, travelling 32 mph in the 20 mph school zone, and 3 citations for using a cell phone while driving were also issued.
