



NEIGHBORHOOD TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT PROGRAM APPLICATION INFORMATION

32.14.033 Application

Any ten citizens and/or business license holders or an Association by vote of its board may file an application for a Neighborhood Traffic Management Program (NTMP) project. An NTMP project application may include a request to install one or more traffic management devices in order to alleviate a particular traffic management problem. An NTMP project application may also include a request to remove or modify an existing traffic management device or devices. The application shall be filed with the Public Works Department on such form as is prescribed by the City Manager.

32.02.010 Definitions

Citizen – Any registered voter within the Lake Oswego Urban Services Boundary.

Upon receiving the completed application, a traffic study will be conducted to determine if the street meets the criteria for traffic calming. If the street qualifies, a public hearing will be held before the Transportation Advisory Board, who will approve or deny the request. Current City policy states that approved traffic calming projects will be funded 50% by the applicant and 50% by the City, contingent upon the City having funds available.
